

This activity appears in the section *Energy in Your Life*. It asks students to identify sources of heat, light, sound, and motion that use electricity. Students' answers will vary and may include the following:

- Heat Sources: Furnace*, wall heater*, space heater*, water heater*, microwave oven, electric stove, toaster, toaster oven, crock pot, dishwasher, air fryer, clothes dryer*
- Light Sources: Overhead lights, desk lamp, streetlight, traffic light, digital clock, flashlight
- Sound Sources: Computer, cell phone, stereo, radio, TV, car alarm, smoke alarm, electric instruments
- Motion Sources: Fan, blender, electric vehicle, electric bike or scooter, drone

^{*} Items marked with an asterisk may run on natural gas in some areas.

If students need help identifying items that run on electricity, suggest they look for items that have a power cord, a charging port, or a battery compartment.
